News You Can Use (me = Paul Raff, the TA):

3. Homeworks: I will grade all the homeworks using the following method: I will pick two even-numbered problems from the assignment and score them with 0,1 or 2 points. Then there will be 3 more points given for overall quality of the homework, with an emphasis on neatness and clarity. 2 more points will be given for overall correctness of the homework, and 1 point will be given for having a full homework assignment. Therefore, there are a total of 10 points for each homework assignment. **Homework will be collected at the beginning of class. If you walk in late, you must turn in your homework before you take a seat.** The two lowest homework grades will be dropped. **Homeworks must be stapled. Un-stapled homeworks will not be graded.**
4. Quizzes: I will give a quiz at the end of each recitation (except the first), each being worth 10 points. 15 minutes of class time will be given for each quiz, and you may work up to 10 minutes more after class ends. You should, however, be able to finish within the 15 minutes given. The quiz will cover topics done in the previous week, and it will definitely help to pay attention to what is happening in recitation!
